

## STEP 1




## STEP 2

After you have taken a picture of your favoured place, brainstorm a Go-Cart that will suit the image. Get creative and get your imagination going.

## STEP 3

Using materials at home, create your Go-Cart. You can use cardboard for the overall shape, some buttons for the wheels, and some aluminum foil for some shiny details. Get creative!



TIP: To make the wheels move, use string, yarn, or a pipe cleaner, and put it through the holes in the middle of the button. Make a hole through the cardboard and put all of the string, yarn, or pipe cleaner, through it. Fasten it to the back carefully with some tape.
